

ACP's Evidence-Based Clinical Programs Help Facilitate Higher Five-Star Quality Measure Ratings for Established Customers

In the Accelerated Care Plus (ACP) Five-Star Quality Measure Study, The Moran Company analyzed data from the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services Nursing Home Compare website to determine whether skilled nursing facilities (SNF) which implemented ACP's evidence-based clinical programs had higher quality ratings than other SNFs. The Moran Company compared the components of Five-Star ratings of facilities which have used ACP programs for three years or more to facilities which have used ACP programs for less than three years, as well as facilities which had not implemented the ACP programs.

The SNFs which implemented ACP's evidence-based clinical programs have higher ratings for quality of care than SNFs where ACP programs have not been implemented.
